This notice serves to inform all concerned of Rwanda Civil Aviation Special Regulation number RSR/01/2021 amending Ministerial Order No. 01/CAB.M/019 of 06/02/2019 amending Ministerial Order No. 04.CAB.M018 of 24.07.2018 issued in Official Gazette No. Special of 27 July 2018.

Special Regulation number RSR/01/2021, which takes effect on August 6, 2021, amends RCARs Parts listed below;

- Part 4: Airworthiness of Aircraft.
- Part 7: Personnel Licensing.
- Part 11: Aerial Work Operations.
- Part 22: Air Traffic Services.
- Part 26: Aerodromes and Ground Aids.
