Subject: Industry Comments on 2019 Fees and Charges

Reference is made to the fees and charges published in the 6th Edition amendment 03-19 of Aeronautical Information Publication which became effective on September 2019.

As we recall, Rwanda Civil Aviation Authority placed on its website the proposed fees and charges in May 2019 for industry review and feedback. On the 24th of May, 2019, an email was dispatched inviting all stakeholders to a consultative workshop which was conducted on 31 May 2019 at RCAA facilities.

By the set deadline of 31st May 2019, the Rwanda Civil Aviation Authority had not received any objection and therefore proceeded to publish the fees and charges.

Notwithstanding the above, the decision to publish the fees and charges currently in force considered the following:

- Increased safety oversight responsibilities to enhance safe operations by air operators;
- Encouraging operators to employ improved fleet planning;
- In support of increased aviation activities and maintain at minimum air operator operation costs, the fees and charges were kept on cost recovery basis; and
- Since 2010, Rwanda CAA had not reviewed fees/charges for the services it offers in comparison to the increasing need to ensure safety and security.

Once again, Rwanda Civil Aviation Authority welcomes feedback from the aviation stakeholders that aims at enhancing industry operational safety and sustainability.
